 - i. 2018 Earthquake:
 - 1. \$38,963,542.56 Projected Amount
 - 2. \$27,895,620.32 Total Paid (as of 12/22/23)
 - ii. COVID-19:
 - 1. \$126,798,397.94 Projected Amount
 - 2. \$121,364,639.20 Total paid (as of 12/22/23)
- b. State-declared disasters:
 - i. 2021 Southcentral Storm: (100% reimbursed)- Permanent work @ Ruane Road is pending funding.
 - ii. 2022 Hiland Avalanche: (100% reimbursed)- Closed on 12/6
